The Engineer represent the Company's acceptance of all installed equipment and systems and functions as a technical resource for SRMG departments, plants, terminals and facilities. Reports directly to the Sr. Engineer.

Essential Requirements:

- Ability to wear all required safety equipment including but not limited to hardhats, safety glasses, safety harness, ear plugs, dust masks and gloves

- Ability to do bending, kneeling, twisting, in confined spaces and awkward position
- Ability to ascend and descend stairs, ladders, embankments and stockpiles
- Perform repetitious arm, hand and leg motion

- Bachelor's degree in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering, or equivalent degree or technical experience in a related field
- Minimum five years experience in cement manufacturing (or a similar heavy industrial process) in roles pertaining to project engineering or management
- Intermediate knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point, Access, Outlook and Project
- Valid driver license and acceptable driving record and must be able to travel in state and out of state, possibly in inclement weather
- Able to work weekends when necessary and be on a call-out basis

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform calculations, write specifications and request for proposals, review equipment proposal and drawings, evaluate and select equipment and prepare various lists, such as equipment and materials and create drawings such as piping, physical layouts and other drawings used in design and construction

- Manage capital projects related to engineering specialty and support other staff with capital projects according to technical knowledge
