Primary Job Function:

Maintain an efficient, safe, stable, clean environment in accordance with company policies and procedures, standard practices and safety regulations. Operate gypsum crushing and wash plant systems to clean material for cement plant usage. Operate mobile equipment for quarry, crushing and wash plant operations. Perform material cleanup of the crushing and wash plant systems.

Essential Requirements:

- Wear required safety equipment including but not limited to hardhats, safety glasses, safety harness, ear plugs, dust mask and gloves, and operate mobile and fixed equipment in a safe manner
- Physically capable of climbing up and down, above, inside and under equipment.
- Able to perform shoveling
- Capable of doing repetitious arm, hand and leg motion
- Stand and sit for considerable amounts of time
- Bend and lift up to 100 pounds safely
- Ability to use the following:
 - air and hand tools such as chipping guns, jackhammers, shovels and brooms in work areas
 - hammers up to sixteen pounds and knocker wrenches of various sizes up to 4"
 - every size of ratchets and wrenches
 - electrical and air operated hand tools such as drills and grinders
 - air impact wrenches to 1 - 1/2" and hydraulic torque wrench
 - large bars and chain hoists to align or move equipment
- Required and predictable attendance

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- High school diploma, GED or equivalent
- Three to five years experience in gypsum, aggregates, cement or construction industry preferred
- Experience in the washing or crushing of materials preferred
- Three to five years experience operating a CAT 623 Paddle Wheel Scraper required.
- Operate mobile equipment such as scraper, dozer, loader, water truck, excavator, backhoe, grader and skid loader - 1/2 yard for quarry, plant crushing and wash plant systems
- Some mechanical maintenance, welding and/or equipment operating experience required
- Read and write for record keeping and logs, and understand basic blueprints
