Primary Job Function:

Perform early a.m. start up and pre-inspection of equipment. Maintain fluid levels, lubricate, service, fuel and maintain grease systems.

Please see below a brief summary job description.

Essential Requirements:

- Able to wear all required safety equipment including but not limited to hardhats, safety glasses, safety harness, ear plugs, dust masks, and gloves
- Maintain a Class B – CDL, motor Vehicle Record, HAZMAT Tanker Endorsement, and a DOT Medical Long Form
- Be able to lift up to 100 pounds of weight properly
- Ability to do bending, kneeling, twisting, in confined spaces and awkward positions for extended periods of time to maintenance equipment
- Able to climb stairs and ladders
- Able to do repetitious arm, hand and leg motion to maintain/grease equipment
- Work in inclement weather when required or as assigned
- Required and predictable attendance

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of mobile equipment and lube systems
- Able to maintain a maintenance log
- Able to understand control instruments
- Able to work various schedules including overtime, holidays, call outs and weekends as needed

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Know and follow all company safety procedures and policies; including but not limited to lock out tag out procedure
- Operate lubrication truck
- Perform equipment early a.m. start up
- Check condition of mobile equipment before starting, check for leaks, hoses, fan belts, tires and lights
- Check water levels, (engine, transmission, hydraulic, hoist/torque converter and rock oil) and replenish as necessary
- Check water levels and maintain proper levels of antifreeze in radiators
- After start up check engine oil pressure, brake system air pressure and brake accumulator pressure for proper operation
- Grease equipment daily or as needed
- During fueling and lubrication operation, make visual inspections to equipment and report any needed repairs to Supervisor
- Maintain lubrication truck in clean, orderly manner
- Perform oil changes
- Perform bi-weekly service of air filters as needed
- Perform clean-up in work and shop areas
- Perform other assigned work incidental to this classification
