- Perform repetitious arm, hand and leg motion
- Work various schedules including overtime, holidays, call outs and weekends as needed
- Required and predictable attendance

- Two to five years of experience in the aggregate or surface mining industry preferred

- Check oil levels and replenish as necessary
- Perform oil changes
- Check water level and maintain antifreeze in radiators and maintain batteries
- During fueling and lubrication operation, make visual inspections of equipment and report any needed repairs to Supervisor
- Complete lubrication check lists
- Maintain lubrication truck in clean, orderly manner
- Check condition of mobile equipment before operating, including tire inflation, brakes, oil, hoses, belts, filters, and air pressure; add fuel, oil and water as needed
- Complete operating report of repairs needed and equipment serviced
- Assist Mechanics as required
- Replace grease lines
- Maintain daily operating reports as required
- Able to perform clean-up
