Essential Requirements:

- Ascend and descend stairs and ladders, climb up and down, above, inside and under equipment
- Able to bend, kneel, twist in confined spaces and awkward positions for extended periods
- Lift up to 100 pounds of weight properly
- No fear of heights up to 460 feet
- Use electrical and air tools, such as large grinders, drills of all sizes, chipping guns, knocker wrenches, small jackhammer, large hammers (up to 20 lb. sledge hammer)
- Handle large impacts 2" plus, some dual man operations

- Mechanical and maintenance experience required; ball mills, crushers, vertical mills and belt conveyors preferred
